
NIGHTMARE KING


F‡UR EYES


NUGLY

As the festival from hell continues with no end in sight, and Rafi finds herself growing closer to River, she begins to discover that his secrets have much bigger consequences than she ever imagined.




THE STATISTICAL PROBABILITY OF LOVE AT FIRST SIGHT




